Ensemble services (Woodwind, Brass Ensembles, etc.)

Auditions will be held Friday, September 18, 2009 from 10:00am - 12:00pm in Ballet Studio 1, located in the Cultural Center for the Arts, 1001 Market Ave. North, Canton, OH 44702. Preliminary auditions will be held 10:00 - 11:30am, with the final round beginning immediately after.

Per service rate for the Principal Trombone position was \$115.94 for the 2008-2009 season. Per service rate for Ensemble services was \$92.75. The current Master Agreement is under negotiation. Some services require daytime availability.

Repertoire for the audition includes a solo work for the Trombone plus the following CONFIRMED excerpts:

Strauss	Till Eulenspiegel
Wagner	Die Walkure - major and minor calls
