TITLE: Education & Community Engagement Intern
REPORTS TO: Manger of Education and Community Engagement
TIME FRAME: September - December

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION: Assists with implementation and creation of educational and community programs. Will work with the Manager of Education and Community Engagement to execute programming, plan for the 2021-2022 season and create new ideas for the education and community engagement department.

PROCESSES AND DUTIES:

- Assist with the execution of fall educational programs including after school involvement, and Young Person’s Concert.
- Assist with continued community engagement with nursing homes, nature centers and other community entities.
- Prepare for spring programming by assisting with educational content for programs such as Listen @ the Library, SymphonyLand, and Kinder Concert.
- Run the Canton Youth Symphony Facebook page and assist with other marketing, funding efforts, and website development.
- Assist with application process for the Orchestrating Change Leadership Program, and Composers Fellowship.
- Organize data from past seasons.
- Brainstorm ideas for future education and community engagement programming.
- Be a representative of the Canton Symphony at community events.
- Internship may be tailored to fit specific skills of the intern.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Majoring in Education, Music, Arts Management or some other related field (or equivalent experience)
2. Outstanding computer, written and spoken communication skills.
3. Organizational skills, and the ability to adapt when necessary to the changing needs of the organization.
4. Ability to work independently.
5. High degree of creativity in problem solving.
6. Good knowledge of classical music and extraordinary ability to advocate the cause and benefits of the Canton Symphony Orchestra

TYPE OF POSITION: \$250 stipend. Part-time with flexible hours. Includes some nights and weekends. Primarily remote internship with some in-person requirements.
